**Science:** This week we will continue our stars and universe unit. Students will be able to develop and use a model of the Earth-sun-moon system to explain the cyclic patterns of lunar phases and eclipses of the sun and moon. Students will also be able to develop and use a model of the Earth-sun system to explain the cyclical pattern of seasons, which includes the Earth's tilt and directional angle of sunlight on different areas of Earth across the year. Students will be making connections to the role of gravity in the motions within galaxies and the solar system. 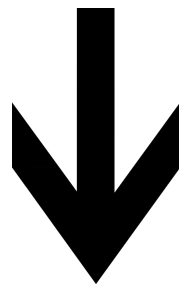
